You are a beautiful lady inside and out! Thank you for welcoming us into your heart - we feel very fortunate to have known you and be a part of your family.

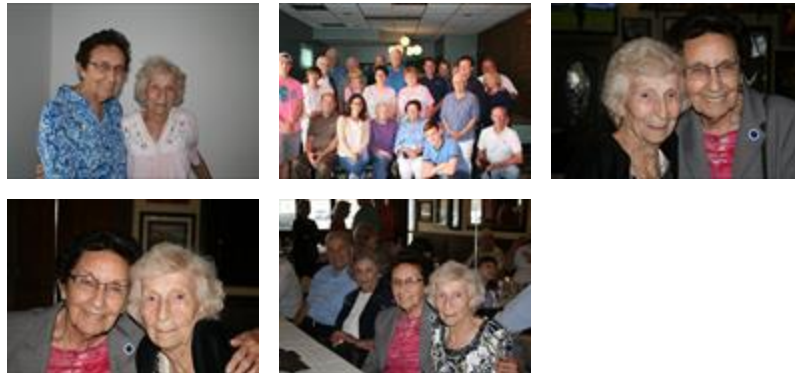
