Feeding the stray cats in her neighborhood was very important to her. Three times a day

she'd place a fresh bowl of cool water out for them along with a good helping of canned and dry food; they ate like kings! She loved them all so much and gave them nicknames; Stud, Boots, Joker, Jorge, Daisy and Fritz.
