John Stephen Maggio, Jr. With heavy heart, the Maggio family shares the passing of John Stephen Maggio, Jr., age 75 on August 10th, 2022.

After a brief but aggressive battle with cancer, John went on to be with his loved ones who preceded him: mother, Sarah D. Maggio; father, John S. Maggio Sr.; life-partner, Patricia Broderick; and many aunts and uncles.

John was the eldest of four beloved siblings and is survived by: brother, Joseph (Ursula) Maggio; sister, Doris (late Ron Sr.) Loconti; brother, Lawrence (Sandra) Maggio.
